### 60-124 Inlet Seal Replacement

### 36-XXX Series Air Assist Tips

The 36 series tips are manufactured from tungsten carbide, tungsten carbide is a highly abrasive resistant material, it is also brittle to shock from drops, please handle these tips with care, if dropped the damage will show up in the spray pattern, replacement would be necessary, there is no way of repairing damage to the tips. It is best to remove the tips, from the gun, clean and soak in solvent until you plan to spray again, this will prevent material from drying in the tip. The carbide tips do not contain iron, they will not rust or flake like other metals. The carbide can darken over time but has no effect on its properties.
